- **45 students** (36%) obtained an ENTER of 95 or higher
- **71 students** (57%) obtained an ENTER of 90 or higher
- **85 students** (69%) obtained an ENTER of 85 or higher
- **6 perfect study scores** (50) were achieved in the following subjects:

Jie (Linda) Gao (Mathematical Methods), Emma Green (History: Revolutions), Virginia Pilcher (Physical Education), Julia Wang (Chemistry, Specialist Mathematics and Physics)

The ENTER is the score used for tertiary entrance. It is also a measure of a student's ranking within the State. Hence 57% of MGGs students obtaining an ENTER of 90 or above means that these students are within the top 10% of the State.

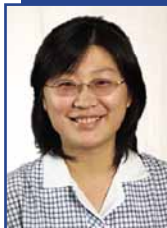
