- **42 students** (34%) obtained an ENTER of 95 or higher
- **61 students** (50%) obtained an ENTER of 90 or higher
- **77 students** (63%) obtained an ENTER of 85 or higher
- **88 students** (72%) obtained an ENTER of 80 or higher
- **4 perfect study scores** (50) were achieved in the following subjects:
Michelle Li (Chemistry and English), Rosalie Riebl (Literature), Alison Hiong, Year 11 student (Mathematical Methods)
- **3 students received First Class Honours** in the University of Melbourne Extension Program (UMEP):
Michelle Li (Mathematics), Yun (Selina) Shen (Mathematics) and Marina Connelly (English Literature). Marina was also awarded the UMEP Prize for Excellence in English Literature as the highest achieving student in the course.

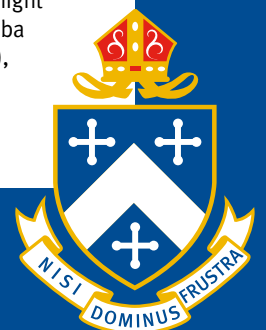
The ENTER is the score used for tertiary entrance. It is also a measure of a student's ranking within the State. Hence 50% of MGGs students obtaining an ENTER of 90 or above means that these students are within the top 10% of the State.

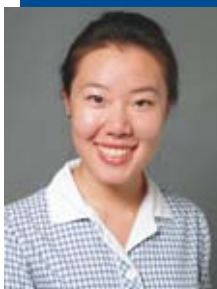

The School warmly congratulates our highest achiever for 2007, Michelle Li, who obtained the maximum ENTER score of 99.95. Michelle achieved a perfect score of 50 for Chemistry and English, and First Class Honours in the University of Melbourne Extension Program study of Mathematics.

In 2007, Michelle received prizes for Excellence in Chemistry, English, Physics and Specialist Mathematics, and was awarded the Winifred Waddell Memorial Prize for Mathematics and the Phelia Grimwade Memorial Prize for Science. Michelle has also been awarded a place in the University of Melbourne Kwong Lee Dow Young Scholars Program.
