- **10 students** (8%) obtained an ENTER of 99 or higher with one student obtaining a perfect ENTER of 99.95
- **42 students** (32%) obtained an ENTER of 95 or higher
- **67 students** (50%) obtained an ENTER of 90 or higher
- **84 students** (63%) obtained an ENTER of 85 or higher
- **99 students** (74%) obtained an ENTER of 80 or higher
- **10 perfect study scores** (50) were achieved by the following:

The ENTER (Equivalent National Tertiary Entrance Rank) is the score used for tertiary selection. It is a measure of a student's ranking within Victoria based on VCE results. With 50% of MGGS students obtaining an ENTER of 90 or above, this means that these students are within the top 10% of the State.

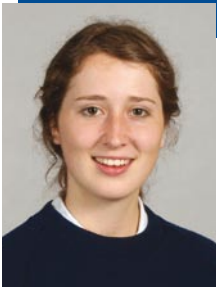
